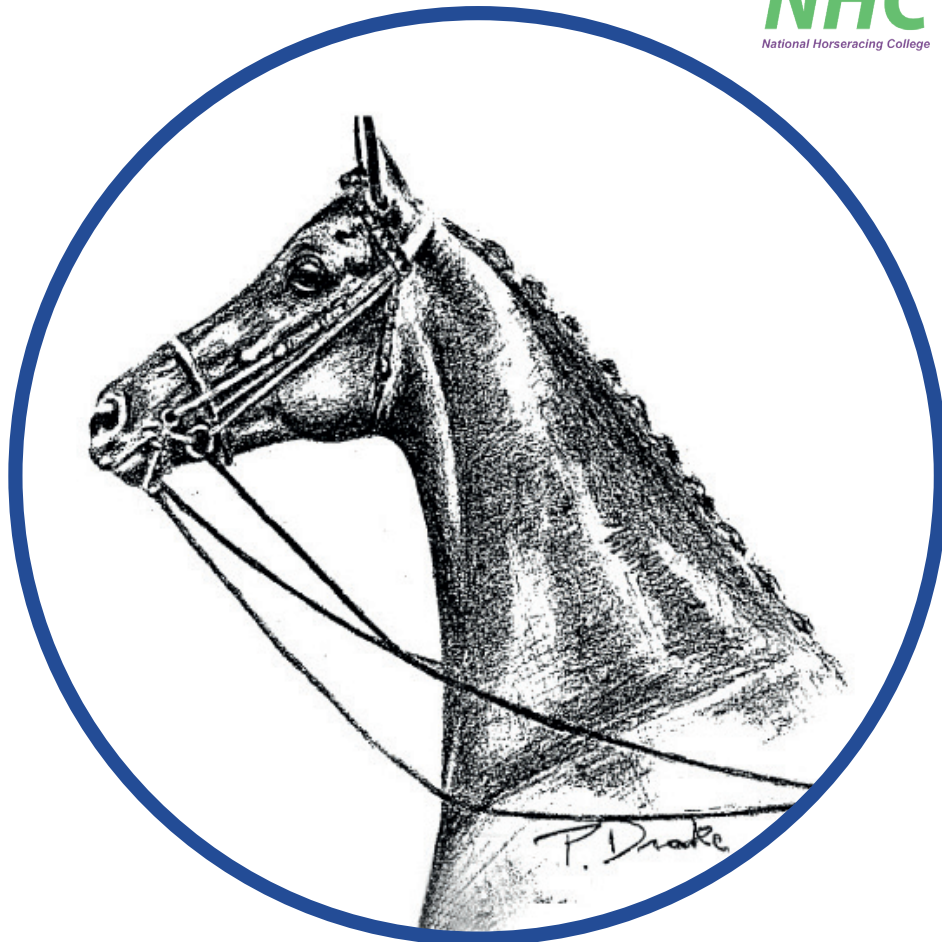

Winter Championship Qualification!

1st-3rd placed ponies in classes 1-10 will qualify for the 2021 BSPS Winter Championship

Class 1: BSPS Novice Pony of Show Hunter Type. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 2: BSPS Novice Pony of Show Hunter Type. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 122cms and not exceeding 133cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 3: BSPS Novice Pony of Show Hunter Type. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 133cms and not exceeding 143cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 4: BSPS Novice Pony of Show Hunter Type. Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 143cms and not exceeding 153cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 20th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

NOVICE SHP CHAMPIONSHIP

Class 5: BSPS Novice Show pony mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 128cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 13th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 6: BSPS Novice Show pony mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 128cms but not exceeding 138cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 15th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 7: BSPS Novice Show pony mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 138cms but not exceeding 148cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

NOVICE SP CHAMPIONSHIP

Class 8: THE BSPS NOVICE SMALL INTERMEDIATE SHOW RIDING TYPE Animals ex.146cms.but not exceeding 153cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year. .

Class 9: THE BSPS NOVICE LARGE INTERMEDIATE SHOW RIDING TYPE Animals ex. 153cms., But not exceeding 158cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 10: THE BSPS NOVICE INTERMEDIATE SHOW HUNTER OF 2020 Animals ex. 148cms., But not exceeding 158cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year. .

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CHAMPIONSHIP

Class 11 – 13 are not a qualifying class for the BSPS Winter Championship!

Class 11: BSPS NOVICE LEADING REIN PONY Ponies not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 12: BSPS Novice First Ridden Pony mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 13: THE BSPS NOVICE LEADING REIN PONY OF HUNTER TYPE Ponies not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

SP/SHP LR/FR CHAMPIONSHIP

Novelty Classes Not before 12 pm

Class 14: Young Handler, 10 years and under Handlers not to have attained their 11th birthday by 1st January of current year. **No stallions.**

Class 15: Young Handler, 11 to 16 years Handlers to have attained their 11th birthday not their 17th birthday by 1st January of current year. **No stallions.**

Class 16: First Year Combination. Riders and ponies in their first year of competing. Ponies not exceeding 128cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 17: Best Dressed Halloween Costume In Hand or Ridden, in walk only. Junior riders / handlers may be assisted.

Class 18: M&M Novice Lead Rein. Registered pure bred mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 19: : M&M Novice First Ridden. Registered pure bred mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 128cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

M&M LR/FR CHAMPIONSHIP

Class 20: M&M Novice Ridden Small Breeds registered in the breed society stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A and Welsh B. Ponies 4 years old and over. Riders any age.

Class 21: M&M Novice Ridden Large Breeds registered in the breed society stud books of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C and D. Riders any age.

M&M BREEDS CHAMPIONSHIP

Class 22: Tiny Tots First Time in Show Ring Leading Rein ponies not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 5th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Open to both plaited and Heritage ponies.

Class 23: Tiny Tots Leading Rein ponies not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 5th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Open to both plaited and Heritage ponies.

Class 24 and 25 are not qualifying classes for the BSPS Winter Championship

Class 24: BSPS TINY TOTS WALK AND TROT CLASS Plaited or Heritage Ponies not exceeding 128cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies will only walk and trot in this class.

Class 25: BSPS TINY TOTS RIDDEN Plaited or Heritage Ponies not exceeding 122cms. Suitable to be ridden by a rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

In this class Ponies will be asked to canter in their individual shows only.

! Please read:

All ponies must be 4 years old or over.

Rosettes to 5th place in all classes.

These will not be presented in the ring, you will be asked to collect rosettes after your class.

Whilst NOT competing.

Please remain in your lorry/car.

You will have to create your own number.

You will be contacted prior to the show with your allocated number.

Only 3 people per horse/pony are allowed at the show.

No spectators or members of the general public aloud.

Rules and conditions

This show is affiliated to the BSPS and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in the BSPS classes whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the constitution and rules of the BSPS including disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

Neither the bsps area 3B committee, nor any of w officers, servants or assistants shall be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal or property in connection with this show.

Each exhibitor shall abide by and accept as final the decision of the judges, referees, chief steward and officials of the show.

The judges in the schedule have accepted our invitation to judge, but the committee reserve the right to appoint substitutes if necessary.

No exhibitor may knowingly show a pony under a judge in circumstances that would constitute a breach of rule 486 by the judge.

Any pony taking part in classes judged under BSPS rules will be liable to dope testing.

No Refund of entries will be made, except in the event of unforeseen cancellation of the show, when a £7 levy per entry will be made to cover administration costs.

In all classes correctly secured British Standard skull caps/Riding Hats that meet current safety standards MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted.

Entries at this show are limited to 5 per class.

Entries will be open from Sunday 11th October (6pm) to Sunday 25th October.

Entries are £20 per affiliated class and £12 for unaffiliated.

Please provide your email address, your mobile phone number and any **vehicle registrations** that will be attending the show that associate with you (clients cars)! If you do not, then the vehicle will not be allowed to enter the event.

A timetable will be produced once the entries are closed - there will be specific times for each class and very specific working in times.

Do NOT arrive any sooner than 1 hour before your class, this allows plenty of time to tack up and warm up.

Once you have finished your class please return to your lorry and leave the centre.



British Show Pony Society

Guidelines for exhibitors/members at shows

- The society expects each member/exhibitor to take personal responsibility for not spreading the Covid-19 virus and obeying all rules regarding social distancing.

Failure to do so will result in removal from the showground.

Please do not attend if you are classified as being in a vulnerable category as per government guidelines.

Events will only take place when government guidelines allows them to do so.

- **DO NOT attend if you are displaying any signs on the Coronavirus symptoms.**

- Social distance from members other than your family group by 2 metres (or current government guidelines).
- Must use hand sanitisers on regular basis.
- Wash hands thoroughly on arrival and after using any facilities throughout the day.
- Use lorry toilets where possible to minimise the risk.
- Obey orders given by loudspeaker system regarding social distancing.
- Wear face coverings wherever possible to avoid spreading the virus.
- Temperature checks MAY be taken during the show.
- Ensure you arrive in the designated vehicle on your entry and be prepared to give names of occupants on arrival at the Show.
- Ensure you park lorries and cars safely where directed by the officials.
- Abide by the Rules in the Schedule.
- Only animals competing at the show will be allowed on the showground.
- Show Organisers have taken responsibility to set safeguards in place for exhibitors but attendance at the Show is at your own risk.

Driving Directions.

FROM THE M1/M18

1. Leave M1 at junction 32, then join the M18 motorway signposted "The North".
 2. Leave the M18 at junction 3, the A6182 exit to Doncaster.
 3. At the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Great Yorkshire Way/A6182.
 4. At the roundabout take the 1st exit and stay on the Great Yorkshire Way.
 5. At traffic lights at Hare & Tortoise pub slight right onto Bawtry Road/A638, continue to follow A638 towards Bawtry.
 6. At traffic lights straight on follow A638/Great North Road.
 7. Continue past the Mount Pleasant Hotel on your right.
 8. The entrance to the College is signposted and is on your right.

FROM THE A1 (TRAVELLING FROM THE SOUTH)

1. Leave the A1 at junction 34. On the 1st roundabout take the 4th exit, then at 2nd roundabout take the 1st exit onto the A614, signposted Bawtry.
2. At roundabout take the 1st exit onto the A638 signposted Bawtry.
3. Entering Bawtry continue straight on, A638 (Great North Road) signposted Doncaster.
4. Keep on the A638 and you will pass a caravan centre on your right, followed by a water tower on your left, and then the Paintball Fields and RSPCA Centre - also on your left. Approximately 50 yards further on you will see the NHC gallops on the left hand side.
5. The entrance to the College is signposted about another 100 yards on your left.
